

## **Electric Guard Dog Working to Stop Crime**

COLUMBIA, SC (12/28/09) — Stopping crime from occurring at a customer's site is Electric Guard Dog's mission. Electric Guard Dog also believes that a mission of businesses that provide security measures to commercial sites is to work with organizations like the Southwest Transportation Security Council to stop crime.

"The bad guys work 24 hours a day to get the goods they want," Jack DeMao, Electric Guard Dog CEO said in response to news about the surge in building supply thefts. "Unfortunately, theft counter measures have not been getting as much dedication. Electric Guard Dog has a strong interest in sharing security measures information with the SWTSC and other security councils across the country."

Total Cargo theft is estimated to be as high as \$30 billion a year, DeMao said. "It's not just the manufacturers that are the victims. Every business involved with moving product along the supply chain, as well as the end consumer, is affected through higher costs and unmet demand."

Building material theft is just the latest segment of cargo theft to grow dramatically in a down economy. Recently there has been a surge of thefts of truckloads roofing shingles. The scope of these thefts has suggested a highly organized attack.

As a member of the SWTSC, Electric Guard Dog is participating in a specialized effort to focusing on Building Supply theft.

DeMao believes that "all businesses involved with security: those needing security measures, the providers of those measures and the government agencies that enforce the measures, can break the chain of criminal activity that surrounds the loss of goods in the building supply industry, just to name one, and within the shipping logistics pipeline by sharing information and working together."
